Application Preparation Guide

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Before you begin

Choose the program you are interested in and check your eligibility.

Ensure you meet minimum eligibility to apply including English language requirements.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Graduate Certificate or Professional Certificate

To apply for the online Graduate Certificate or Professional Certificate in Business Administration, applicants must have:

- An undergraduate degree AND at least two (2) years of documented full-time professional work experience, OR
- A minimum of six (6) years of documented full-time professional experience
- Met the University's English language requirements.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Masters or Graduate Diploma

To apply for the online MBA or online Graduate Diploma in Business Administration, applicants must have:

- An undergraduate degree AND at least two (2) years of documented full-time professional work experience, OR
- A minimum of six (6) years of documented full-time professional experience
- Contact details for two professional referees
- Met the University's English language requirements.

APPLIED BUSINESS ANALYTICS

Graduate Certificate

To apply for the Graduate Certificate in Applied Business Analytics, applicants must have:

- Completed an undergraduate degree, and
- Two years of documented full-time professional work experience
- Met the University's English language requirements.

APPLIED BUSINESS ANALYTICS

Masters or Graduate Diploma

To apply for the Master or Graduate Diploma in Applied Business Analytics, applicants must have:

- An undergraduate degree in any discipline and weighted average mark (WAM) of 65% in the Graduate Certificate in Applied Business Analytics, or
- An undergraduate degree in one of the related areas: commerce, mathematics, physics, computer science, information systems, engineering or science and
- Two years of documented full-time professional work experience
- Met the University's English language requirements.



Before you begin

Ensure you meet minimum eligibility to apply including English language requirements.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

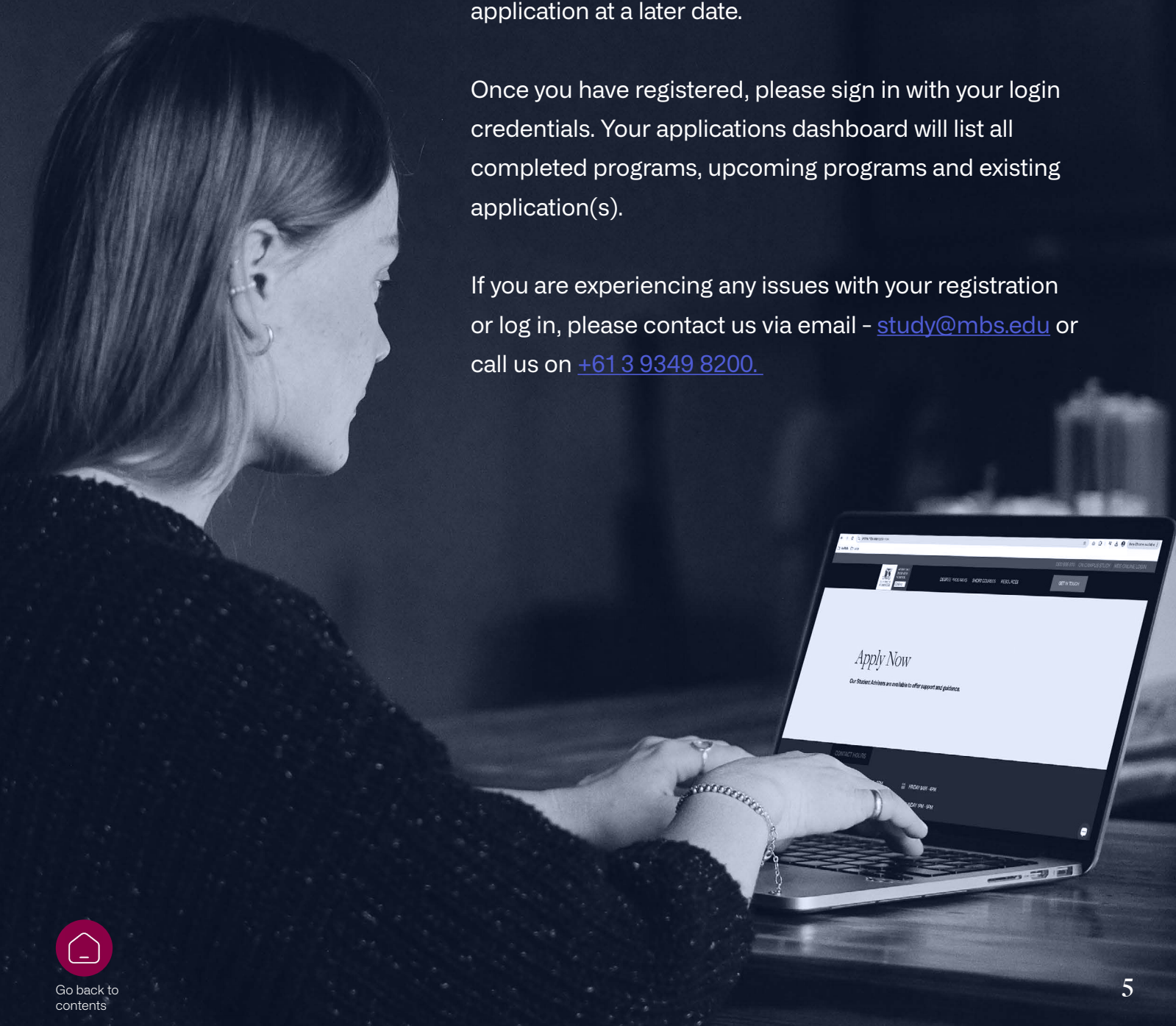


Registration

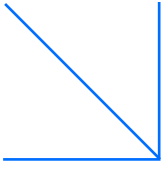

As part of your degree program application, you are required to provide supporting documentation.

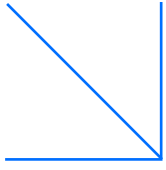
Below are some examples of the types of documentation required for each section. It is important to get your documentation right, otherwise your application may not be considered.

Documentation tips:

- If any of your documents are not in English, you will need to provide certified translated copies. Our preference is translations made by [NAATI](#) qualified translators.
- Ideally, you should upload one document per section. If you have multiple documents for a single entry (e.g. Transcripts and Certificate), please combine these into a single PDF document. If you are unable to upload a PDF document, the system supports other document formats, including .doc files.



Identity

Australian citizens are required to provide one of the following:

- Citizenship Certificate
- Birth Certificate
- Valid passport (showing passport ID number, place of birth, DOB, Expiry date).

Australian Permanent Resident and other visa holders are required to provide all the following:

- Valid passport (showing passport ID number, place of birth, DOB, Expiry date), AND
- A copy of your current valid visa letter (if applicable).

If your name differs on your supporting documentation, please provide one of the following:

- Change of name certificate
- Marriage Certificate.



Personal Statements

Personal statements are optional for the Graduate Diploma and Master of Business Administration should you wish to provide additional information where necessary to strengthen your application.

These are the optional questions:

1. Are there any additional comments you would like to make to help us better assess your application?

For example, major personal or professional achievements, management or leadership experience or major life events that may strengthen your application.

2. Please explain any periods of poor academic performance and how you have reflected and grown from them.

Referees

Note: Referee details are only required for the Master of Business Administration and Graduate Diploma in Business Administration.

If needed, please provide contact details of two professional referees. Your nominated referees should:

- Have known you for at least six months and can speak to your skills, experience and character in a work or professional setting.
- Be a professional referee such as a manager, supervisor, client, or stakeholder. Reports from friends, relatives, or personal relationships will not be accepted.

Please note, when reviewing your complete application, the Selection Committee may contact your referees for further information.



Academic History

If you have completed any tertiary studies, please provide the following:

- Official academic transcripts and evidence of completion for all completed tertiary qualifications.
- Academic transcripts for any incomplete or attempted tertiary studies (if applicable).

Academic transcripts must include:

- Your name and the name of the awarding institution
- Each subject taken and the mark/grade received
- An explanation of the grading schema.

Please note: If you have received Advance Standing for prior learning, please make sure to submit the academic transcripts that display the results where the Advance Standing was granted.

Employment History

CV/resume

Your CV/resume should include:

- Employment history including duration (month and year), tasks or duties and responsibilities for each role to date
- Education
- Volunteer work/internships (if any)
- Achievements
- Awards/prizes/scholarships (if any).

Please note that evidence or an explanation is required for any gaps longer than six months in your CV/resume.

You may also provide your LinkedIn and/or work reference letters (where applicable).



English Language

IELTS (Academic English only), TOEFL Internet-based Test, Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE), Cambridge C1 Advanced, LanguageCert Academic, or Michigan English Test (MET) scores are required for entry.

Course specific requirements can be found above under 'Before you begin'.

If you've completed an undergraduate degree, or a graduate degree of at least two years duration, where the degree was taught and assessed entirely in English, you may satisfy the [University's English requirements](#). Applications will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Please note:

You can only submit results from one sitting within 24 months preceding the proposed date of commencement of enrolment.

The University does not accept the revised TOEFL Paper-delivered Test of ITP. The University also does not accept any online/at home versions of the tests listed above. English language proficiency tests must be taken at a test centre in one sitting.

The University will only accept approved English test results conducted in the student's country of citizenship, their last country of education, or their current country of residence or employment.



Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) may be considered based on professional qualifications or prior study of relevant subject(s) at a recognised academic institution.

RPL options depend on your selected program. These details are outlined below.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

If applying for the online Graduate Diploma in Business Administration or the online MBA, you may be eligible to apply for RPL for up to 4 core subjects.

The core subjects eligible for RPL are:

- Data Analytics for Decision Making
- Finance
- Financial Accounting
- Managerial Economics
- Managing People
- Marketing
- Operations
- Strategic Management.

APPLIED BUSINESS ANALYTICS

If applying for the Graduate Diploma in Applied Business Analytics or Master of Applied Business Analytics, you may be eligible to apply for RPL for up to 4 subjects (50 credit points).

Subjects eligible for RPL are:

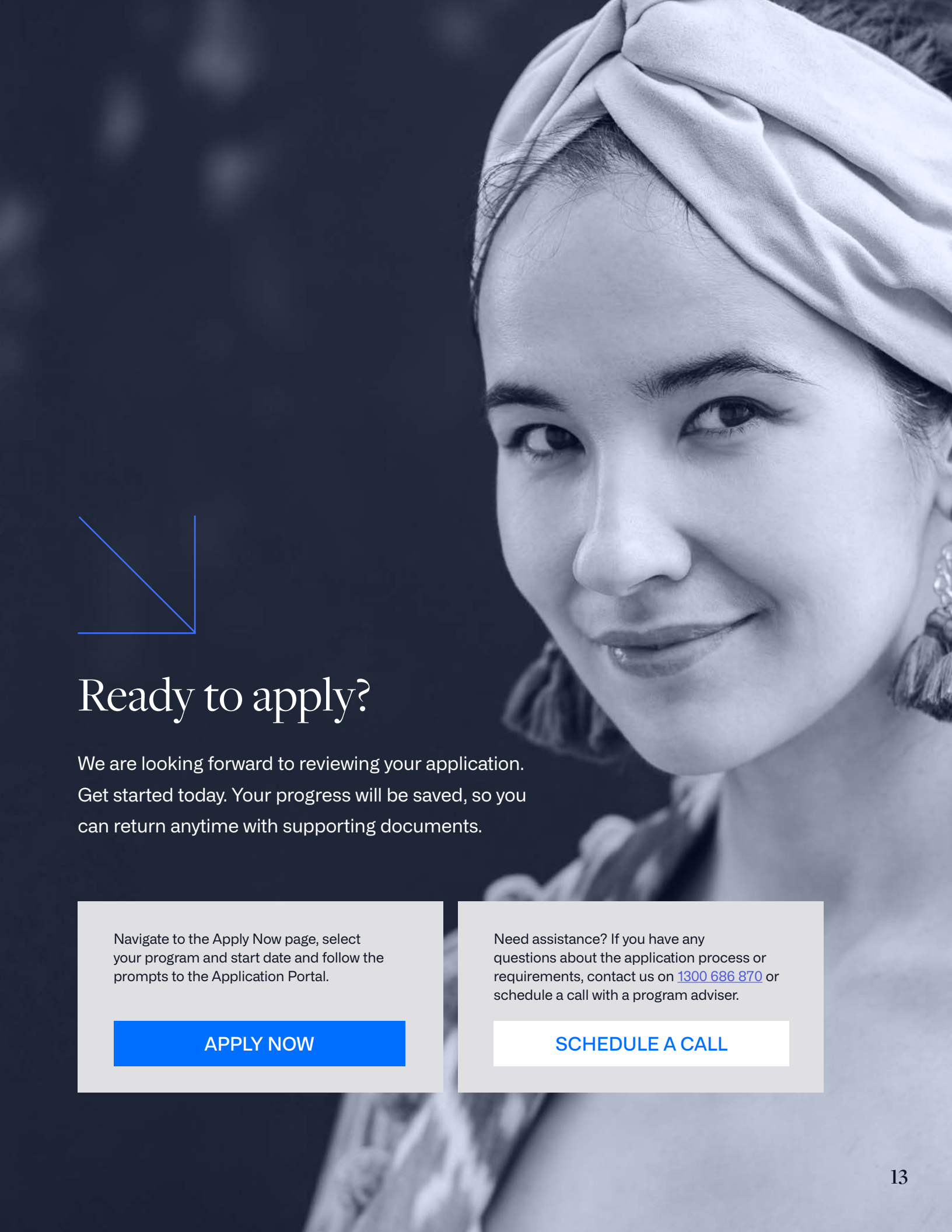
- Foundations of Data Analysis
- Programming for Analytics
- Data Platforms for Analytics
- Modelling and Predictive Analytics.

Please note: Time limitations as well a credit cap will apply according to school policy. RPL is not available for other Melbourne Business School online programs.

To apply, please provide the following:

- Academic transcript/s (as per the Academic History section)
- Unit outline/Subject syllabus (for each subject) in the year it was completed
- Evidence of a professional qualification
- Evidence of extensive work experience in the relevant subject (Applied Business Analytics program only).
